Grand Centennial Parade (July 25, 2010)

That was when President Franklin Roosevelt reviewed 27,000 Scouts who lined both sides of Constitution Avenue for three miles! On the day before the opening of the 100th Anniversary National Jamboree, our Cubs, Scouts, Venturers, and Explorers will be joined by Scouting units from all around the country to form a BSA Grand Centennial Parade on Constitution Avenue in Washington, DC. There will be floats, marching bands, balloons, horses, historic uniforms, lots of flags, and thousands of Scouts marching and reviewing! **Be there!**
